**ORDER**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On March 25, 2021, pursuant to sections 45 and 46 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA), Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. (PNG) filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) seeking approval for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to design and construct a new let-down station #1 (LDS #1). LDS #1 will be dedicated to provide new natural gas service to JGC Fluor BC LNG Joint Venture (JFJV) as engineering, procurement and construction contractor for the permanent administration and non-process facilities being constructed as part of the LNG Canada liquified natural gas (LNG) export facility in Kitimat, British Columbia (LNGC Project) (Application);
- B. In the Application, PNG also seeks approval under sections 39 and 59 to 61 of the UCA to enter into a gas sales agreement to provide natural gas service to JCV for an initial period of 26 months;
- C. PNG requests to have BCUC approval of its Application by no later than June 30, 2021, and encourages the BCUC to consider expediting its review of this submission; and
- D. The Panel has reviewed the Application and considers that a public hearing for the review of the Application is warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE** the BCUC orders as follows:

1. A public hearing process is established for the review of the Application in accordance with the Regulatory Timetable, as set out in Appendix A to this order.
2. PNG shall provide an electronic copy of the Application and this order by no later than Friday, April 16, 2021 to all parties who participated in the PNG 2020-2021 Revenue Requirements Application proceeding, the

PNG 2019 Consolidated Resource Plan proceeding and any municipalities or districts who lie within PNG-West's service territory and the Haisla Nation.

3. PNG must post the Public Notice, similar in format and content to Appendix B of this order on its website and on its Twitter, LinkedIn and Facebook social media platforms, on or before Friday, April 16, 2021. It must also publish weekly reminder notices on each platform until the conclusion of the intervener registration period on Monday, April 26, 2021.
4. In accordance with BCUC's Rules of Practice and Procedure, parties who wish to actively participate in this proceeding, must submit the Request to Intervene Form, available on the BCUC's website at <https://www.bcuc.com/get-involved/get-involved-proceeding.html>, by Monday, April 26, 2021, as established in the Regulatory Timetable attached as Appendix A to this order.

## PNG's APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT LDS#1

On March 25, 2021, Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. (PNG) filed its Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to design and construct a new let-down station #1 (LDS #1) in Kitimat, BC to provide non-process natural gas to the LNG Canada liquified natural gas export facility. The estimated cost of the project is \$1.9 million. PNG also requested approval of its Gas Sales Agreement (GSA) with JGC Fluor BC LNG Joint Venture (JFJV) as engineering, procurement and construction contractor of the LNG Canada site.
